- 10. Park all cars, busses and campers in specified areas.
- 11. No smoking or any other use of tobacco at camp.
- 12. Campers are not to enter the area designated for the opposite sex.
- 13. Campers are to attend all scheduled activities.
- 14. Campers problems are to be handled first by their counselor; then, if necessary, by the Camp Director. Final decisions concerning the emotional, physical, moral or spiritual problem of the camper will be made by the camper's pastor. (Problem campers will be sent home!)
